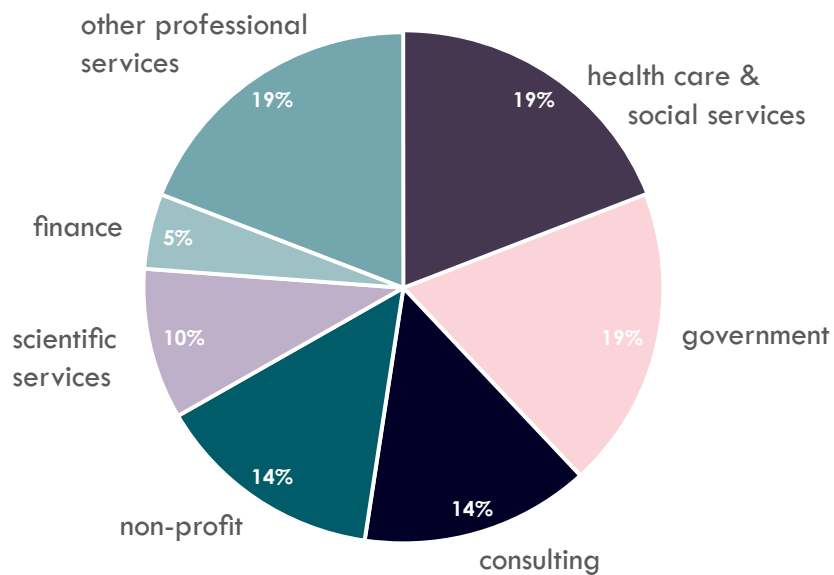

The Rotaract Club of Chicago has **25** active members

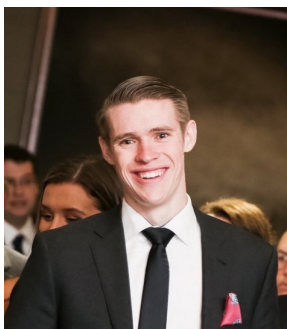


Our members are involved in a wide range of **industries** in the Chicagoland area

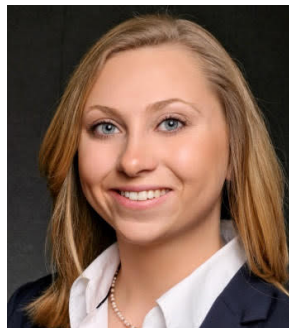
